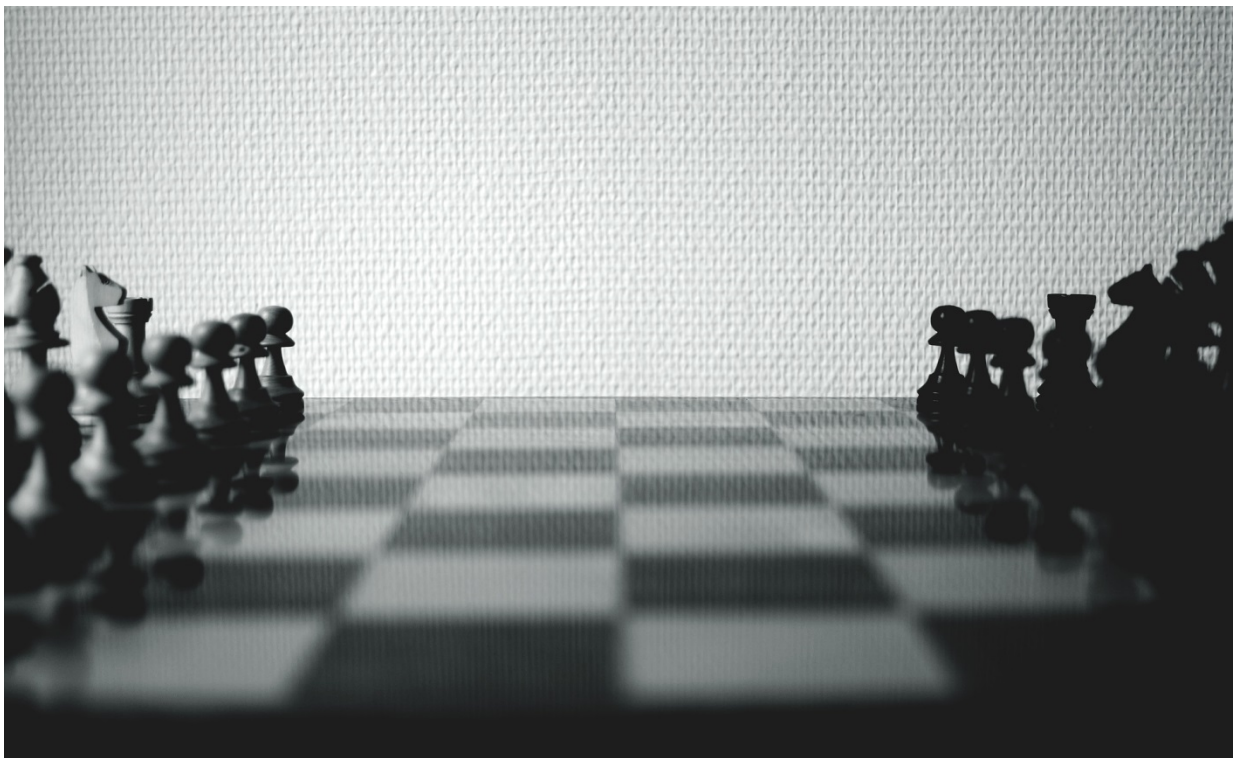


# The dangerous military act in support of Venezuela that now threatens Colombia



The Colombian government affirmed on Tuesday that the deployment or the military incursion in favor of the Nicolás Maduro regime is a threat to peace, security and stability in the region. The dangerous military act in support of Venezuela.

"Colombia reiterates that any deployment or military incursion in support of the Nicolás Maduro regime jeopardizes the democratic transition and constitutional normalization in Venezuela, and constitutes a threat to peace, security and stability in the region," said the foreign minister, Carlos Holmes Trujillo.

The foreign minister responded to an information in the newspaper El Tiempo according to which the Russian ambassador in Colombia, Sergei Koshkin, sent a letter to Congress warning the Andean country that a military incursion into Venezuela will be considered a threat to peace and the international security.

For his part, President Ivan Duque said this morning that his country "is not in the plan to attack any State" and added that Colombia, "is in its duty to defend the Inter-American Democratic Charter and to denounce the abuses with clarity and forcefully of the dictatorship of Venezuela . "
